

Conflict mineral sourcing policy applies to the selection and retention of Orient Cables (India) Ltd.(OCIL) suppliers, who provides materials containing 3TG (tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold).

OCIL is committed to working toward avoiding the use of minerals from conflict affected and high-risk of Areas i.e. Conflict region of Democratic Republic Congo and its surrounding countries (DRC region), which are affected by the risks defined in the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development(OECD) Due Diligence Guidance within supply chain.

OCIL expects its suppliers to take every effort to avoid minerals that are not found to be sourced responsibly.

In support of this policy OCIL will ;

- Identify the supplier and parts having Conflict Minerals- Tantalum, Tin, Tungsten and Gold (3TGs) in our products and processes.
- Inform suppliers about Conflict Minerals to ensure compliance.
- Ensure suppliers are giving declaration / certificate mentioning smelter information / country of origin during supply.
- Review compliance process for adequacy and update as and when needed.
